

HOOK “n” BANG Rules

- Five species – boar, goat, snapper, duck, pheasant
- To be eligible for the competition you must enter 4 of the five species. However, the points system favors the entry of all 5 species.
- Up to 5 people in a team – entry fee \$200 per team
- Competition starts Thursday 19th May 12.01am. Final weigh in 4pm Saturday 20th May at Poroti Tavern
- Prize giving at 5pm at Poroti Tavern
- Weigh in starts at 2pm and ends at 4pm Saturday 20th May (time based on judges watch)
- No entries accepted after 8pm Wednesday 17th May

- Judge’s decision will be final
- All game must be caught between Thursday May 18th and last weigh in 4pm 20th May Saturday
- No frozen game
- No rotten game
- No badly mutilated pigs will be accepted
- All game must be wild and caught or shot under fair chase
- All game animals and fish to be taken away by teams, nothing to be left at Poroti Tavern

Points system:

- One Boar or barrow must weigh minimum of 30kg, must be weighed in one piece with head intact. One point for each kg
- One goat horns. Only head required. Ears must be left on. Horns measured from tip to tip. 1 point for each cm.
- One snapper must be over 35cm, 1 point for every cm.
- One duck – can be paradise duck (shell duck), mallard duck or grey duck. **NO CROSSBRED DUCKS**. Ducks are weighed. 1 point for every 100grams.
- Winner of competition will be the team with the highest points.
- One cock pheasant. Bars on tail are counted. 1 point per bar.
- 20 Bonus points for entering all five species.

In the case of teams having equal points at the end, the team that weighs in first takes the superior prize.
